A local Stay Tax applies on all hotels and apartments throughout Malta. Fees vary depending on the official star rating and must be paid locally by the clients upon checkout.

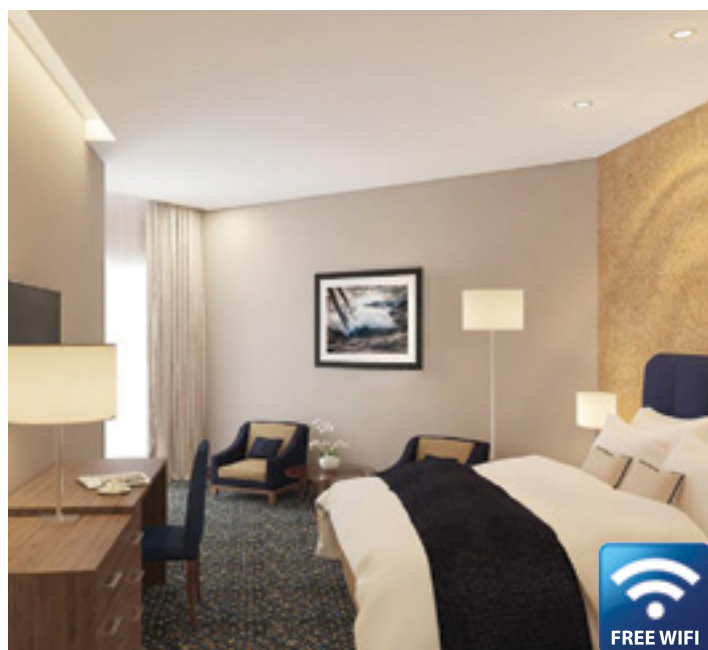

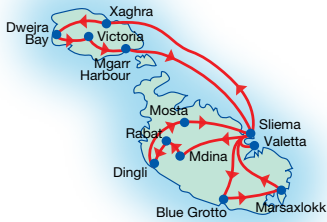

Blue Grotto

Departs: Saturdays 9 Mar-16 Nov 2024

Day 1 Sat: Catania

Arrive at the hotel in the city of Catania. In the evening you will meet your tour-leader and your travel companions and enjoy a welcome dinner. Overnight at Il Principe Hotel or similar. (D)

Day 2 Sun: Catania-Syracuse-Noto-Ragusa

After breakfast visit Syracuse, greatest Greek colony in Sicily and a World Heritage Site. The visit will start with the Archaeological Park of Neapolis with its Greek Theatre, Roman Amphitheatre, Latomie of Paradise, and Ear of Dionysius. Continue visiting the splendid Ortigia, a small island which is the historical centre of Syracuse. In Ortigia you will admire the beautiful Cathedral which dominates the square with its authoritative presence. From Piazza Duomo you will reach a wide terrace on the waterfront surrounding the famous Arethusa's Fountain, one of the most famous freshwater sources of the Greek world. Free time for lunch. Departure to Noto, the capital of Sicilian Baroque, famous for its fine buildings of the early 18th century and declared Unesco World Heritage Site. We will visit Palazzo Nicolaci Villadorata, beautiful noble residence in Baroque style and once the residence of Don Giacomo Nicolaci, a patron of the arts. Continue to Ragusa for dinner and overnight at Mediterraneo Palace Hotel or similar. (B, D)

Day 3 Mon: Ragusa-Modica-Piazza Armerina-Agrigento

After breakfast visit Ragusa and its historical centre cradle of Sicilian Baroque. In the past used as a location of the popular TV series "Police Inspector Montalbano" this ancient town is a home to more than 50 churches and many other architectural treasures and is also one of 44 Italian World Heritage Sites. The tour then continues towards Modica, a charming town with tiny streets. Here you will stop at 'Sabadi', one of the most renowned chocolate manufactures and will have an opportunity to enjoy a multi sensorial chocolate tasting. Next stop is the beautiful and perfectly preserved noble 17th-century Palazzo Castro Polara Grimaldi. You will have time to savour some local delicacies under the shadow of the amazing Orti di San Giorgio: 7 gardens suspended between light and beauty. We will then reach Piazza Armerina where we will admire the splendid polychrome mosaics of the famous Villa Romana del Casale, World Heritage Site. The complex includes some of the most extensive and most beautiful Roman mosaics known. Continuing to Agrigento for dinner and overnight at Baia Di Ulisse Wellness & Spa. (B, D)

Day 4 Tue: Agrigento-Marsala-Salt Road-Palermo

Continue to Agrigento where we will visit the famous Valley of the Temples, a World Heritage Site. You will see the "Temple of Hera", the "Temple of Concordia" and the "Temple of Heracles". Next stop is the town of Marsala. After a walk along the city centre, guided tour of the Florio Cellars. After a 30min tour through the barrel vaults, where the ancient tuff stone floor has been restored, you will reach the avant-garde tasting rooms named Donna Franca and Duca Enrico. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we will not be responsible to you for any loss, damage, personal injury or delay attributable to the actions or omissions of an Independent Supplier. Any claims you have in this regard must be made against the Independent Supplier. You acknowledge that the Independent Supplier's liability to you may be limited by their own terms and conditions.

Services we directly supply

To the extent only that we are the principal supplier to you of travel arrangements or other services which we control, then we will provide those travel arrangements and services with reasonable skill and care.

We will only be responsible for our employees in the course of their employment, and for our agents and suppliers (where we are not the supplier's agent or where the supplier is not an Independent Supplier) if they were carrying out the work we had asked them to do.

We will not be responsible for any loss, damage, claim or expense caused by the acts or omissions of yourself, of any other third party not connected with the provision of the travel arrangements or services, or due to an event of Force Majeure.

While we endeavour to meet scheduled arrival and departure times, we cannot guarantee this. We will not be responsible for any loss or additional expenses you incur for any missed connections/services attributable to delays.

General liability limitation

You acknowledge that travel arrangements or services which comply with local laws and regulations will be deemed to have been properly performed, even if this would not be considered the case in Australia.

Australian Consumer Law and corresponding legislation in State jurisdictions in certain circumstances imply mandatory conditions and warranties into consumer contracts ("Consumer Warranties"). These Booking Conditions do not exclude or limit the application of the Consumer Warranties. Other than the Consumer Warranties, we disclaim all warranties.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, our maximum liability to you under these Booking Conditions, in tort (including negligence) or at law is limited to arranging for the travel arrangements to be resupplied or payment of the cost of having them resupplied.

COMPLAINTS

In the event of a problem with any aspect of your travel arrangements you must tell us or make our representative or our local supplier aware of such problems immediately.

We will only consider and be responsible for claims made against us where we or our suppliers have had the opportunity to put things right on the ground. If you notify us of a problem during travel and we haven't resolved it to your satisfaction, then you must make any claim in writing within 30 days from the end of your travel arrangements.

DEEMED ACCEPTANCE

If you place a booking on behalf of another party, you represent and warrant us that you are duly authorised to provide the agreement and consent of the other party to be bound by these Booking Conditions. You agree that you will be responsible for any loss or damage we incur if this is not the case.

GENERAL

The contract between Greece and Mediterranean Travel Centre Pty Ltd trading as Greece and Mediterranean Travel Centre or Luxury Greece Collection and you is governed by the laws of the State of New South Wales. Any disputes shall be dealt with by a court with the appropriate jurisdiction in New South Wales.
